Job Summary JOB OVERVIEW

The Research Data Analyst will work with principal investigator (PI) and team on the evaluation of the multiple sexual and reproductive health programs within California. The position's primary responsibility is to provide technical assistance to properly administer evaluation activities to agencies implementing Adolescent Sexual Health (ASH) programs funded through California Department of Public Health's Maternal, Child and Adolescent Health (MCAH) division. The individual will assist with verification of data collected by the agencies including pre/post surveys of participants, attendance logs, and fidelity checklists. This includes reviewing data for accuracy and providing feedback to the agencies through check in calls, emails, data dashboards, and occasional site visits. The Research Data Analyst will verify submitted data and provide technical assistance by phone and email to local agencies to properly administer evaluation activities. The individual will perform basic qualitative and quantitative analyses of results and prepare findings for reports, articles, and presentations.

In addition, the Research Data Analyst will work on the evaluation of California's Preterm Birth Initiative, including organizing and facilitating focus groups and interviews, conducting observations, and help design and test survey instruments. The Analyst may work on other research projects and conduct literature reviews.

The position also is responsible for managing all meeting logistics and materials for project meetings and brown bag informational sessions. This includes preparing meeting agendas, reminders, and minutes. In addition, the individual will be responsible for tracking project deliverables and preparing progress reports.

The Research Data Analyst may need to travel throughout California, on occasion for meetings and/or to conduct interviews or collect data.
