Research Manager

Advancing New Standards in Reproductive Health (ANSIRH) is a program of the Bixby Center for Global Reproductive Health; a multi-disciplinary academic center focused on the most pressing need for adolescent sexual health, family planning, abortion policy, maternal health and sexually transmitted infections. The Bixby Center is a key research entity of the ZSFG Division of the Department of OB/GYN & RS at UCSF.

ANSIRH is recruiting a Research Manager (Data Research Analyst III) to work on the Abortion Facility Standards Initiative (AFSI). AFSI seeks to ground public and policy debate about abortion facility standards in solid evidence and genuine public health approaches so that standards in this field are based on science, not politics. The Research Manager will be a key member of the AFSI team and will work specifically on the 21st Century Approach to Public Health and Abortion project. The Research Manager will work closely with the PI and Project Director to lead key research projects related to Health Departments' involvement in abortion care. In collaboration with the Principal Investigator (PI), they will design study tools, obtain IRB approval, recruit, conduct interviews, perform analysis of data, and contribute to manuscripts. They will also develop training curriculum based on these interviews and the evidence base and coordinate pilot trainings of Health Department staff and Public Health Students.

The Research Manager will also work closely with the Project Director to develop content for the Facility Standards Development (FSD) Initiative and assist with the planning and execution of the FSD Summit. In collaboration with the Project Director, they will prepare research and policy background materials for the FSD Summit, manage logistics and administrative components of the Summit and other Initiative efforts, and create and manage project management tools to ensure the smooth operation and functioning of the FSD Initiative.

Required qualifications:

- Bachelor's degree in public health, health policy, social science, or related area and three to five years of related work experience; and / or equivalent combination of education and experience / training
- Experience with research design, implementation, and analysis and IRB experience
- Thorough knowledge of research function
- Thorough skills associated with data analysis, particularly qualitative data analysis
- Thorough skills in analysis and consultation
- Skills to communicate complex information in a clear and concise manner both verbally and in writing
- Experience developing curricula and other training materials
- Skills in project management
- Research skills at a level to evaluate alternate solutions and develop recommendations

Preferred Qualifications:

- Master's degree in public health, health policy, social science, or related area and / or equivalent experience / training
- Experience working in reproductive health, in particular abortion care
- Experience working with health departments
- Experience with UCSF policies and procedures and research administration, including UCSF CHR, MyResearch, REDCap and Qualtrics
